SWINE FLU

During the course of the holidays, two members of staff and a number of children had swine flu. Please be aware of the symptoms and if unsure of whether or not your child is experiencing these symptoms, consult your doctor.

The symptoms of swine flu are quite similar to those of regular flu, and include:

- Body aches.

- Sore throat.
