Announcements of participants: 26 November (lists will be on the notice boards and on the D6)

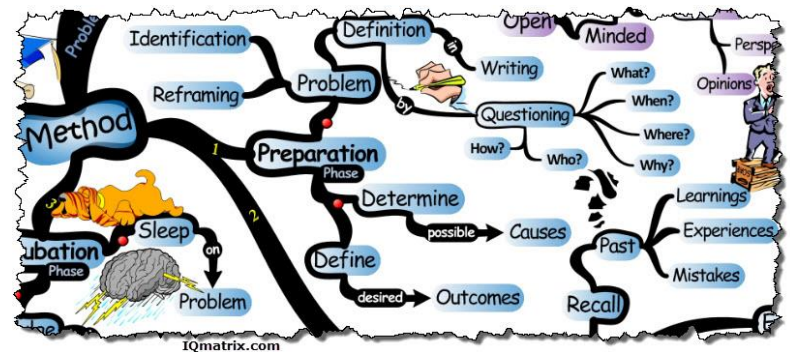
Practice: 28 and 29 November at 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Break
