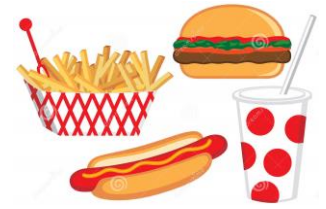

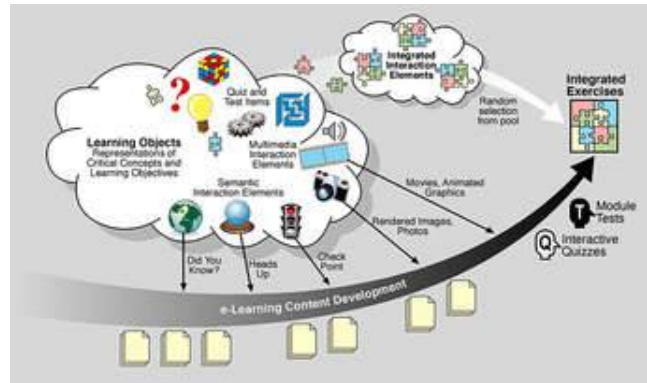

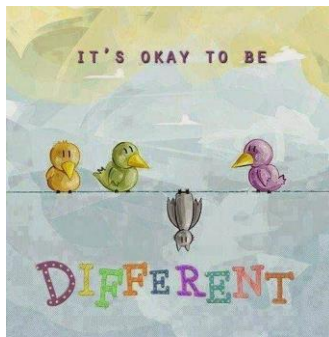
CEA INFORMATION
