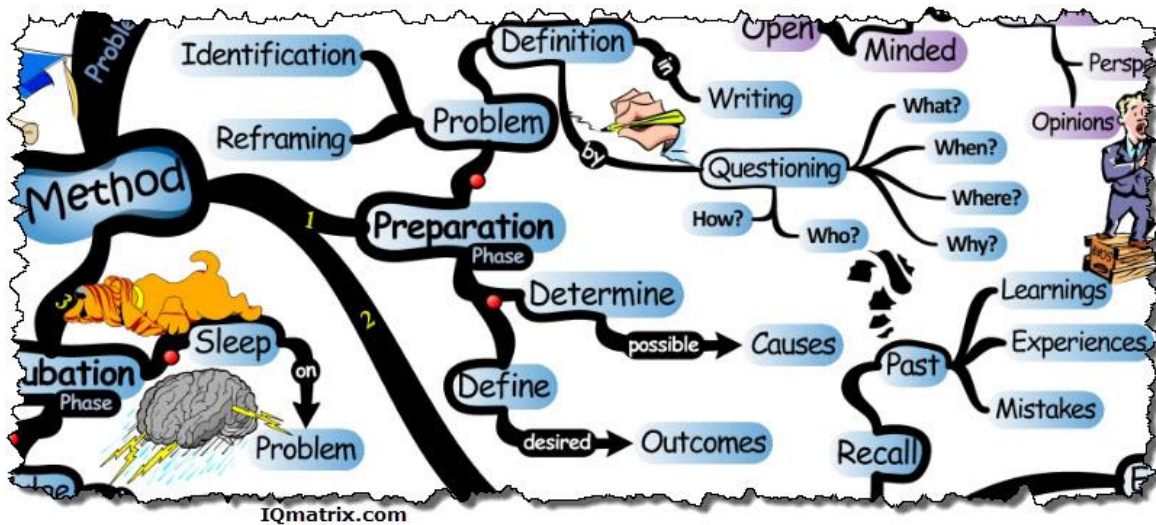
Aarafah Vally (LST) has once again made her office in the Therapy Block available as a prayer place for our Muslim families.
