 INFORMATION**

This week we will be introducing the concept of **THOUGHT INTEGRATION**. This is the ability to combine pieces of information into complete thoughts and hold on to them while needed and to be aware of the need for combining information.

- Encourage your children to become mindful of their ability to combine sources of information so that they can be successful.
- Ask questions that require your children to respond based on the combining of sources of information such as: "How do you know when your mother is mad at you?"
- Point out situations where they can use thought integration. Remind them of the consequences of previous actions - good or bad - before making decisions.
