### MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Please note that the administration and some of the management team will be involved in various stages in the roll out of a new data system at school. This means that, for the next two weeks, certain members of staff will not be available.

### EXTRA MURALS

Extra mural activities begin today. Please check your timetable so that you know what time your child finishes and ensure that your child is collected on time and not left unsupervised in the afternoon. Please be aware that some activities do not have supervision after the finishing time. If you can't remember what was selected, each class teacher has the list up in class or on the class window.

**NB:** Extra mural swimming is also scheduled to start this week.

However, this will depend on the weather and the pool water temperature, so children should bring their swimming kit and a decision will be made on the day. If swimming does not take place, the group will be supervised until the end of the session.
