The Derby is a **TEAM EVENT**. Please encourage your child's participation.

A reminder of some important details:

- There will be no extra-murals on Thursday 14th March.
- On the day, please dress your child/children in their black PE shorts and their class T-shirt colour, and running shoes. Bring them to their class to get ready by 15:00.
- It is the parents' discretion to bring bicycle helmets for your child/children if you feel that they should wear one.
- Derby starts at 16:00.
- Each race will last 20 minutes.
- Sponsored laps will be capped at 50 laps per child.
- There will be a parade of classes and themes, which we encourage the parents/spectators to support and join in the spirit.
- Parents/spectators may also wear T-shirts in the colour of their class to support.
- Sponsorship forms, confirming the number of laps completed and the amount owed by each sponsor, will be returned to parents on Monday 18th March.
- Forms and the correct amount owed need to be returned to school by Monday 25th March.
