Navy culottes/Navy skirt with Navy Opaque tights/long grey socks **OR** long grey flannels; white Crossroads golf shirt/white polo neck top; navy V-neck jersey/Crossroads tracksuit top; black shoes with white socks; school cap with Crossroads badge **OR**

Navy Crossroads tracksuit; white Crossroads golf shirt/white polo neck top; navy V-neck jersey; black shoes and white socks; school cap with Crossroads badge.

**Except for Grade 0 BOYS and GIRLS** who wear a navy Crossroads tracksuit; black takkies with short white socks (girls) and grey socks (boys); navy V-neck jersey/navy Crossroads tracksuit top; school cap with Crossroads badge.
