### MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIAL

It is deeply concerning when parents choose to air grievances on a platform of social media/WhatsApp rather than within a channel where the issues can be discussed. 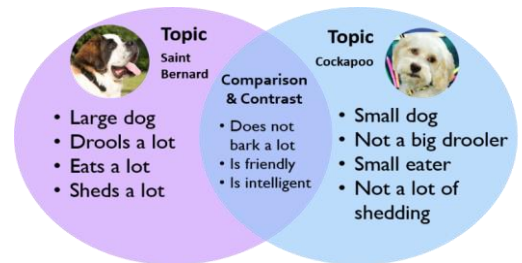
