2ND TERM INFORMATION

Winter Uniform

Pupils may choose to wear either the summer or the winter uniform for the first few weeks of Term 2 while the weather is still variable; however, please ensure that they are wearing full winter or full summer uniform (not a combination of the two). Should they wish to do so, Gr 0 - 2 pupils may wear their tracksuit over the summer uniform in the early mornings for this period. Please ensure that all clothing is marked so that it is easy to return lost items to the rightful owner. The Second Hand Uniform Shop is open on the first Tuesday of each month from 7:15 to 8:15. The shop will therefore be open on the 14th May.

Boys:

Navy Crossroads tracksuit; white Crossroads golf shirt/white polo neck top; black shoes; grey socks, school cap with Crossroads badge **OR** Long grey flannels; white Crossroads golf shirt/white polo neck top; (Grade 6 and 7s may wear a white long sleeved buttoned shirt) navy V-neck jersey/tracksuit top; black shoes with grey socks; school cap with Crossroads badge.

Girls:

Navy culottes/Navy skirt with Navy Opaque tights/long grey socks **OR** long grey flannels; white Crossroads golf shirt/white polo neck top; navy V-neck jersey/Crossroads tracksuit top; black shoes with white socks; school cap with Crossroads badge **OR**:

Navy Crossroads tracksuit; white Crossroads golf shirt/white polo neck top; navy V-neck jersey; black shoes and white socks; school cap with Crossroads badge.

Except for Grade 0 BOYS and GIRLS who wear a navy Crossroads tracksuit; black takkies with short white socks (girls) and grey socks (boys); navy V-neck jersey/navy Crossroads tracksuit top; school cap with Crossroads badge.
